## PROBLEMS & SOLUTIONS

- ✗ The current playground is dated and no longer meets Calgary Board of Education (CBE) safety standards.
- ✓ The new play park will integrate traditional equipment like swings with newer pieces that include innovative design materials such as nets and ropes for climbing and balancing.
- ✗ The current playground appears as a vast, treeless wasteland.
- ✓ The new play park will provide much-needed naturalization including trees and shrubs for shade, and boulders and logs for creative play opportunities.
- ✗ The current playground sits apart from the school, and the asphalt area adjacent to the building is worn and tired.
- ✓ The new play park will be moved to join the asphalt area and the whole playground will flow in a natural, esthetically pleasing way to form an integral outdoor accompaniment to the 100-year-old sandstone school.
